Schedule & Punctuality

Hosting Games

Hosting Games Game will be hosted by the players themselves from the upper bracket of the match sheet.

Game Times

The official schedule of the competition will be announced in our facebook page and/or on facebook event page. These schedule includes the start time of all matches.

Rescheduling

The change of a match time is only possible under exceptional circumstances and has to be confirmed and agreed by both the opponens and the admin.

During a game

Picks & Bans

The hero pool always consists of all heroes the game mode allows. The game must not be paused during the draft, unless a drafter disconnects.

Pauses

Each team has the right to pause the game for an acceptable duration, if a player announces it at least three seconds in advance and calls a coherent reason (exception: not necessary, if someone disconnects). The game must not be resumed before both teams agree with it. When the number or the duration of breaks becomes too high or long, teams may force the continuation of the game.

Disconnects & Reconnects

If a player disconnects, the game is to be paused instantly. Everyone has up to ten minutes to reconnect to the game (if the same person disconnects more than once, all times get added up). If this time is passed, the opposing team may continue the game. The affected player is in this case still allowed to rejoin later on.

Rematch

If there's a technical issue that requires a rematch. Do contact the admin. Rematches will be same hero under the AP game mode

Bugs

If any serious bugs occur, the game has to be paused immediately and to seek the admin for advice actions. Knowingly abusing a bug is strictly forbidden.

Tools / Hacks

The usage of any Dota-related tool aside from Steam and Dota 2 during a match is strictly forbidden.

Ending

Either team called "GG", "Gg", "gG", "gege", "good game", "ggwp" will be declared as surrender, or players intentionally disconnect. If not, always wait for the ancient to be destroyed!

Rule Violation & Punishment

Breaking of the rules or ignoring the order of an admin may result in a punishment for a whole team or a specific player. Type and amount to be decided by an admin.

Possible Team Punishments

- Default Loss for one game
- Default Loss for the whole match
- Time Penalty for the next draft
- Score Reduction (during a group stage)
- Temporary or permanent ban from the competition
- Permanent ban from the competition
